- Metal R Panels for roof and walls of shelters at least 12' in length.
- 8ft or 10ft wood treated wood post at least 6 in diameter.
- 5ft horse fence 2x4in square.
- Dried or horticultural Molasses, liquid Seaweed.
- Purest form of sulfur dust for the barn to help keep snakes away.
- We are in need of volunteers that can do handy work around the farm.
- Anything we can use in a good yard sale or fund raisers for gifts.
